The successful Respondent must be a MSCAA certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE), in accordance with MSCAA Small Business Participation Program (SBPP) guidance. Since the Disadvantage Business Enterprise program is a part of the SBE program, a certified-DBE is also invited to participate, as well. (Respondent may subcontract with non-SBE/DBE firms; however, SBE must self-perform 30% of total contracted work.) Additionally, Respondent must sign a contract with the Authority that includes Federal Aviation Administration provisions, if applicable, regarding Buy American Preference, Foreign Trade Restriction, Davis-Bacon, Affirmative Action, Debarment and Suspension, and Drug-Free Workplace, all of which are incorporated herein by reference.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all responses to this request in whole or in part; to waive any informalities, technicalities, or omissions related to this request; and to reject responses on any other basis authorized by the Authority's purchasing policies. This project will use various funding sources including, but not limited to, grant contracts with the State of Tennessee and/or the Federal Aviation Administration.
