




Permits

- Replacing the 5 yr/indefinite agreements system
- Renewed annually
- Apply at: https://flymemphis.com/commercial-drive-operating-permit-application/
- Vehicle inventory for LPR system
- Accounts must be current to renew
- All commercial drive operators will transition to permits by 28 Feb 25

Rules & Regulations

Updated to reflect:

- New permitting system
- Changes due to construction
- Upcoming tech upgrades
- Simplify and clarify existing sections
- Enforcement of late fees and penalties

Outer Roadway Construction Project (ORCP)

- The current upper outer driveway will be demolished and upgraded over a two-year period
- The lower middle and outer will close during that period
- There will be a commercial drive management team (CDMT) starting shortly before the closures
- The lower outer drive will close first to prep the new Interim Commercial Curb (ICC)
- Middle drive will close once the ICC is ready
- TNCs pick-up will move to new ICC
- Rental car deliveries to be impacted








Projected Schedule:

Phase I: Commercial Vehicle Curb Assignments

































New ICC Entry Point






New ICC Exit Point







