Item Number 2 Sample Contract, Section 3: Term and Renewal, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following below:

Section 3 Term and Renewal

The initial term of this Contract shall be for a period of five (5) years commencing on the start date of the Contract (Contract Term). The Authority, in its sole discretion, reserves the option to extend the Contract Term for two (2) years (Renewal Term) by giving written notice to the Company at least ninety (90) days before the expiration of the Contract Term or any Renewal Term. At the sole option of the Authority, the Contract may be extended beyond the one (1) Renewal Term. The Contract shall be amended to reflect any negotiated and agreed upon Compensation for any such extension of this Contract.

Any violation or breach of the terms of this Contract on the part of the Company or their subcontractors may result in the termination of this Contract or such other action that may be necessary to enforce the rights of the Parties to this Contract. The duties and obligations imposed by the Contract Documents, as defined in the "Contract Documents" section below, and the rights and remedies available thereunder shall be in addition to and not a limitation of any duties, obligations, rights and remedies otherwise imposed or available by law.
