1.	Is there a DBE/SBE goal on this job? If not, do the forms need to be completed with the bid?
	This project does have a SBPP/SBE Requirements with a SBE Goal of 0%. However, you still need to provide the SBPP/SBE forms listed in Section 13.5 of the RFB.
2.	Can a traffic control plan be provided?
	<p>The Contractor shall be responsible for preparing the traffic control plan in accordance with MUTCD and TDOT Standards. Attachment A in the RFB includes the traffic control requirements.</p> <p>Furthermore, additional traffic control requirements have been added to Attachment A in this Addendum No. 1.</p>
3.	Can work be done at night?
	<p>Yes. Work can be done at night. See Attachment A of the RFB for project requirements.</p> <p>Furthermore, additional project requirements have been added to Attachment A in this Addendum No. 1.</p>
4.	There is mention of a required Bid Envelope on page 23 of 52 of the bid documents. Does the airport require a specific envelope? If so, where is that provided?

5.	Please confirm if the SBPP Termination Request and SBPP Substitution Request forms need to be completed with the bid.

	<p>Seal coat products must be on the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation Qualified Product List for Standard or High-Performance Fog Seals.</p> <p>After contract award, if the awarded contractor has recommendations for a substitute request based on the project requirements, they will be considered on a case-by-case basis. The contractor must not bid assuming a substitution will be approved.</p>
